

Point System Guidelines



Notes:

1. Points may be recorded in ½ point (0.5 point) increments.
2. Do not count any activities twice. For example, if Studio Division rehearsal occurs during class time, this is class time, not extra rehearsal time. If rehearsals are for Nutcracker but the piece is performed at a Benefit Concert, the rehearsal time counts for only one of these.
3. For points with a range, please consider the time and responsibility involved. If you spend 30 minutes setting up for Nutcracker Tea, but another person spent 4 hours, the 30 minutes does not warrant the higher point choice.

Category 1: Participation in Studio Dance Training

Category 1: Participation in Studio Dance Training

Activity	Activity Examples / Description	Point Range
Colorado Ballet Society dance classes.	Any regular classes for which you are enrolled and attend at CBS or through CBS on Pointe from August 1, 2020 - July 31, 2021 (Does not include intensives).	1 pt per 45 hours
Colorado Ballet Society performances including rehearsal and theatre time.	Nutcracker 3, Spring Story Ballet 3, Connexus Production 3, Elevate Production 3, Studio Division Performance 1, School Tour 0.5 per performance up to max 3 points, Praise Ensemble 0.5 per performance up to max 3 points, Arts Council special event, etc. 0.5 per performance. For other performances, please ask. (Does not include rehearsals that occur during class)	0.5-3 points per production. See examples
Studio Intensives and Workshops	Summer Intensives, Online Workshops, etc.	0.5 point per day
Studio Master Classes	In-Studio Master Classes	0.5 point per two classes
Serve as a Teacher's Assistant or Substitute Teacher	Volunteer time spent learning through these activities. 1 point per class assisted each week through the year, up to 3 points. Example: 1 class all year = 1 point. Sub hours throughout the year = 1 point. 2 classes all year = 2 points. 1 class for ½ the year = 0.5 points.	0-3 Points. See examples

Category 2: Participation in Chapter NHSDA Program & Activities

Activity	Activity Examples / Description	Point Range
Attend Meetings	Attend a scheduled NHSDA Meeting	0.5 points per meeting attended
Participate in NHSDA Student Performance	Spotlight	Choreographer: 2 point Dancer: 1 point Crew: 1 point Produce Program: 1 point

Participate in NHSDA workshop or class	Prior examples include the Head Start Classes/Workshops, Teaching a class at Hope & Home Foster Care, Etc.	2 points
Participate in NHSDA Community Performance	Nutcracker Tea	Set-Up/Prep: 0.5-1 point Dance: 1 point Serve food, clean during event: 0.5-1 point
NHSDA Leadership	Holding and participating in the work of being an officer or leadership role in the chapter, ie. President, Secretary, Etc.	1-3 points per season depending on the time spent in the role.

Category 3: Participation in Off-Site Dance Programs

Activity	Activity Examples / Description	Point Range
Dance classes outside of CBS	1 point per 45 hours of class, rehearsal, and theatre time.	1 pt per 45 hours
Off-Site workshops, festivals, or intensives.	Summer Intensives, Camps, Master Classes, Training held outside of Colorado Ballet Society.	0.5 point per day
Productions Outside of Colorado Ballet Society	Example: Dance, Dessert, and Dreams; Benefit Concert; Performances with Colorado Springs Conservatory; School Talent Days/Pep Rallies/Assemblies; School or Community Dance Team/Club; Musical Theatre Productions if dancing; etc.	Choreographer: 1-2 points per production Dancer: 0.5-1 point per production
Participation in Adjudication or Scholarship Competition	Example: Denver Ballet Guild	1 point per event

Category 4: Participation in Activities Related to Dance Productions

Activity	Activity Examples / Description	Point Range
Projects to Prepare for Studio Dance Productions	Preparing flowers for performance sales. Assisting in the costume room.	0.5 - 1 point per activity
Serving During a Dance Production	Includes rehearsal days/times and performance day/time. Children's Division Performance Sparkle Dance Performance Holiday Showcase	0.5-1 point per performance
Participation in Other Duties Related to Dance Production	Stage Manager or Backstage Crew Lighting Designer Set Design or Construction Costume Design or Construction Wardrobe Crew Properties Manager or Crew Sound Technician Make-Up Design or Crew Dance Captain / Rehearsal Director Publicity Box Office Manager or Staff House Manager or Crew Playbill Design and Production Photographer or Videographer Public Relations	0.5-1 point per performance
Attendance at Dance and Related Performances	Attending a dance production in person or virtually (list performance group, performance name, date, location). Examples: Vail International Dance Festival, Watching World Ballet Day, Attending a performance of a professional company, etc.	0.5 points per event
Scholastic Activity	Written papers, essays, articles, interviews, presentations regarding dance topics.	0.5-1 point per item
